# adoIIIG sums of 10 LCHETY SPLIT! 

Directions: Pass out the lickety split game boards. You can play two ways. You can have the class race against an opponent on the board (Draw a target on the whiteboard and when it is time to go - the class is trying to beat the student filling in the blanks at the board). Or race against each other seated at their desks. Students try to fill in the blanks around the target to get the sum of 10 . When a student is done, he yells "lickety split". You can then check their paper - if all answers are correct they win. If not you can check the $2^{\text {nd }}$ person who yelled lickety split. You can place these game boards in plastic sleeves and use dry erase markers to play again and again quickly. There is a recording sheet included for practice or use at a center using a quicksand timer. Your students should know adding sums of 10 facts lickety split in no time!
