Word Study - A) r-controlled vowels with u: UR in a word says "Err!", but when the patter is URE it sounds more like "Yer" or "Your" (cure, pure, sure). B) blends: When 2 consonants come together and blend their sounds, each letter's sound can still be heard. C: syllable breaks: If the vowel is long, the syllable breaks right after the vowel (CV/CVC - la|ter), short vowels break after the consonant (CVC/CVC)
