When your child writes sentences each sentence should include a <u>noun</u> (who is it about?) and a <u>verb</u> (what are they doing?) Encourage your child to *stretch* the sentence by adding details about WHEN, WHERE, WHY, and HOW.

Word Study – <u>A) vowel pairs oo:</u> oo can sound like b<u>ook</u> or m<u>oo</u>n. When your child is reading a new word with an oo pattern, they should try out both sounds to see what sounds right! <u>B) ending digraphs</u> (<u>h-brothers</u>): the sh, ch, and th sounds at the ends of words (also double s) <u>C: syllable breaks</u>: If the vowel is long, it's called an open syllable. If the vowel is short, it's called a closed syllable. This knowledge is helpful for decoding longer and unfamiliar words in reading!
