# **Homework Tips/Reminders:**

We've completed all 3 levels of both addition and subtraction Mad Minutes. Starting this week, students will be revisiting <u>Level 5</u>. These were the hardest for most students. Level 5 focuses on subtraction with minuends 12-18.

**Word Study** – <u>A)</u> -ed: If the vowel is short, double the final consonant to block the vowels from "communicating", if there is a vowel pair in the beginning, no need to double the consonants because the vowels are already communicating. If the word ends in e, just add –d! <u>B) long O patterns:</u> The long O sounds can be made with o\_e (super e) and the vowel pair oa. <u>C): long O sounds in accented syllables</u>: Long vowels will usually make that syllable more prominent than the other, named an accented syllable. Long O is typically made with 2 patterns: o\_e & oa.

**Reading** – Reading Exploring Parks with Ranger Dockett to learn and indentify fact and opinion. When a reader can stop and identify facts & opinions in their reading, they will increase their level of comprehension. Ask your child to share 1 fact & 1 opinion about their day or from a book!
