## What's New: ~ *italics* provide suggestions for guidance at home ☺

**Word Study** – **ALL:** High frequency “sight” words. *These words are expected to be mastered by the end of 2<sup>nd</sup> grade. They should no longer be spelled incorrectly in any writing your child does. Please spend this week focusing on the words that your child misspells or misidentifies in writing & reading.*

**Reading** – Using Student Atlases to learn how to use map features to locate key places on a map. Students will explore the continents and oceans, and learn about north, east, south, and west. *Next time you're planning a trip, share the map with your child! Show them where you live and where you're going. Google Earth is also a great tool to explore!*

**Math** – [A52 -] Data & Graphing: Learning ways to display data through different types of graphs. *When you have family over for dinner, have your child take the drink orders and tally them up. How many want water? Look for graphs and charts in unexpected places. Discuss with your child: What data is this showing? What can you figure out from the data by reading the graph or chart?*

**Writing** – Your child will continue to word process their final writing piece! *Ask your child what keys they've learned on the keyboard. Even better – have them show them to you!*
