Word Study – long and short /i/ sounds in CVC and CVCe patterns. (<u>c</u>onsonant/<u>v</u>owel) *Help* your child look out for "SUPER E!" An e that is one hop away from a vowel will usually make that vowel say its long sound (its name) and the e will remain silent.

Reading – <u>Text:</u> Julius

<u>Skill:</u> Fantasy vs. Realism. *Take a few minutes after your child has read to discuss the story with them. Which parts of the story are fantasy? Did some parts show things that could really happen? (realism)*

Math – [*Mad Minute: A12 +*] Skip counting & comparing numbers. *Practice skip counting during transition times at home (clean up, car rides, getting ready for bed, etc.)*

Social Studies – Citizenship: Rules, laws, local, state, and national government
