Reading – <u>Text:</u> Mrs. Brown Went to Town

<u>Skill:</u> Fictional Story Elements. *Fictional stories are made up of several elements:* Characters, Setting, Problem, Events, Solution, and Conclusion. Ask your child to identify some of these after reading.

Math – [Mad Minute: A14 +] Number sense skills to 1,000. The term "value" is critical to understanding number sense. Point to a digit in a number and ask "What is it's value?"

Social Studies – Finishing up Citizenship, <u>test on Thursday</u>.
