What's New ~ *italics* provide suggestions for guidance at home ☺

Word Study – long and short /u/ sounds in CVC and CVCe patterns. (consonant/vowel)
Help your child look out for "SUPER E!" By now, your child should have a good grasp on the concept of adding an E on the end of a word to change the vowel into a long sound.

Reading – Text: Mrs. Brown Went to Town

Skill: Fictional Story Elements. *Fictional stories are made up of several elements: Characters, Setting, Problem, Events, Solution, and Conclusion. Ask your child to identify some of these after reading.*

Math – [*Mad Minute: A14 +*] Number sense skills to 1,000. *The term "value" is critical to understanding number sense. Point to a digit in a number and ask "What is it's value?"*

Social Studies – Finishing up Citizenship, test on Thursday.
